

# IMPULSE CARTRIDGE TM-BBU-35

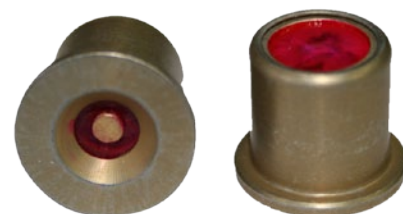
## APPLICATION
